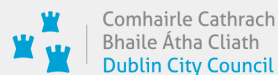

## ABOUT THE ROADMAP

The Dublin Energy Transition Roadmap aims to motivate **a range of stakeholders** such as businesses, communities, academia and public bodies to work together towards the same goal of developing Dublin as a sustainable, healthy, leading carbon-neutral region by 2050.

The Dublin energy agency **Codema** is developing this roadmap together with the four Dublin Local Authorities, Smart Dublin and the Dublin CARO.

**We are now inviting a range of stakeholders to sign up to the roadmap, commit to action and collectively decide the best pathways forward.**



## WHY GET INVOLVED?

- Closely aligned with **EU, national and regional energy & climate targets**
- Opportunity to be seen as a **key influencer** in driving Dublin's low-carbon energy transition

## TIMELINE

### February-March 2021

Leading stakeholders sign up to the Dublin Energy Transition Roadmap and commit to work together to develop actions for the roadmap



### March-October 2021

Series of events/workshops organised by Codema with all stakeholders to establish working groups and discuss actions across each sector



### April - October 2021

Roll out of public engagement campaign to get citizens empowered in the energy transition and to feed into actions in the roadmap across all sectors



### October - December 2021

Present and discuss options for each sector and analyse feedback from citizens and stakeholders in order to finalise and agree priority pathway



### Spring 2022

Finalise Dublin Energy Transition Roadmap, with sign off at senior level. Full evaluation plan developed.
